

## Westwood Drive and 22<sup>nd</sup> junction

- Westwood drive north access to 22<sup>nd</sup> avenue was blocked off in 2018. This was a not the best solution to a problem.
- Traffic trying to get into the two left turn lanes wanting to go north would either go slightly the wrong way to get behind the traffic already in the turn lanes, or pull out blocking the lane of traffic wanting to turn right or blocking the lane of traffic trying to go straight through the intersection.
- Remove all those concrete dividers restoring traffic to 22<sup>nd</sup> avenue.
- Install fencing or dividers between the left turn lanes and the stright through lane from the crosswalk back to where left lane splits to two lanes.
- Before the stop sign on Westwood Drive and on the fencing advise traffic that to go north they must go through the intersection and turn left on central.

This will make the traffic from the Pine Centre and Massey area more efficient.

These removed dividers can be used for the Griffith Avenue to Central Street corridor.
